



Boston Celtics Prime Time Performance Rules



General Requirements and Arena Policies

- Must sell minimum of 125 tickets
 - Only sell the seats that are on your invoice.
 - Invoices contain seats that are reserved for your group.
 - If more seats are needed please contact your representative.
- All performances must be 5 minutes or under.
- All payments must be received one month prior to the performance. This ensures that all tickets can be distributed in a timely fashion.
- The time of performance will be approximately 30-40 minutes prior to the game.
- A public address announcement will be used to introduce and welcome your group.
- Tap performances are prohibited.
- Only use soft shoes or sneakers.
- All participants must sign waivers and have tickets to the game.
- 30 participant maximum.
- All props must approved by Celtics staff before the game day.
- Arena policy requires that patrons not take video footage. Still cameras are allowed (A DVD of the performance will be provided for you at no cost).

Participant and Chaperone Guidelines

- Please arrive at the arena 1 hour and 15 minutes prior to game time.
- Please send a copy of music one week prior to performance and bring a backup copy on the day of the performance.
- Celtics logos and/or name can not be worn on performer's costume (team colors and basketball themes are encouraged).
- Dancers should wear their costumes to the arena and carry as little as possible (Arena policy only allows each performer one small handbag).
- Music should be edited to be appropriate for a family environment. Please refrain from using music containing explicit content and obscenities.
- Only dancers and chaperones will be escorted through the security gate.
- Please notify your Celtics representative one month prior to the performance date if you plan on not using your performance date (All requirements must be met in order to perform).

Parent Information

- Parents are welcome to enjoy the performance from one of our two viewing sections located at the top of Section 14.
- Parents and supporters will enter through the turnstiles with the general crowd, one hour prior to game time.
- Parents and friends can meet the performers in the concourse, behind Sections 17 & 18 after the performance, and then should proceed to their seats.
- Parents are not permitted in the waiting area (Sections 17 & 18) before the performance.
